2 Year Olds

We have had a fantastic and busy autumn term, filled with opportunities to explore, create, and embrace the changing seasons. As the autumn leaves began to fall, the children enjoyed observing their shapes, colours, and textures, collecting a variety of autumn treasures. They even had fun making and playing with *autumnal jelly*, sparking curiosity through sensory play.

The excitement continued with Bonfire Night, where we used flicking paint techniques to create colourful, firework-inspired artwork. It was a fun and messy way to bring the dazzling night sky into our creative play.

We were delighted to welcome a visit from the librarian, who shared wonderful stories with the children and encouraged parents to discover the benefits of joining the library. This was followed by *Odd Sock Day*, where we celebrated individuality with our mismatched socks, and *Children in Need*, where everyone dressed up for a spotty day of fun.







3-4 Year Olds

The arrival of winter brought snow and ice, which the children explored with great excitement. They painted ice blocks and experimented with colours using powder paint and food colouring, creating beautiful patterns and learning about how colours mix. We also enjoyed a heartwarming story-sharing session with children from Ditton Primary School, building connections through a shared love of books.

A highlight of the term was our magical trip to *Delamere Forest*. The children took part in festive forest activities, made their own Christmas tree decorations, and toasted marshmallows, enjoying the wonders of nature in the crisp winter air.

We ended the term in true Christmas spirit, starting with a *Christmas Craft Stay and Play* session where parents joined us to get creative. Together, we decorated Christmas trees, built festive structures using materials like cable reels and cardboard boxes, and finished with a joyful *Christmas Sing-along*, where families came together to celebrate with music and cheer.
